



## 2020 Scott Associates Spring Plant Dividend Pick-up

Wednesday, June 24, 1 to 7 pm

One of your benefits as a Scott Associate is receiving a free spring and fall plant dividend. This Spring, we have some choice plants for your garden. We are excited to continue this tradition while doing so in a way structured to minimize contact and the risk from close interactions. ### Please follow these steps to pick up your Scott Associates Plant Dividend:

- 1) [Review the choices here](#), determine your top three choices. Choices remain while supplies last.
- 2) On a piece of paper, write down your **top 3 choices** so it can be read from 3 feet away.
- 3) **Bring your Spring Dividend postcard and paper list of choices** during the designated pick up time based on your last name. In order to safely manage the flow of people and number of pick-ups at any one time, you will not be given a plant other than during your designated time.



### **Wednesday, June 24 Pick-up Schedule:**

Pick-up times according to the last name on your Spring Dividend Card. (The schedule does not follow alphabetical order. Please review carefully.)

### **By Vehicle:**

4) Enter on College Avenue, go around the Rose Garden Circle, and line up staying in your car behind the Scott Office Entrance Drive

5) We will hold up a container for you to deposit your spring plant dividend postcard into, then please hold up your paper up so we can see your top plant choices.

5) **Please do NOT get out of your car.** Pop your trunk, and if that is not possible, roll down your back passenger window or leave the back door unlocked.

6) We will select your Spring Plant Dividend plant, and place it in a Scott tote bag and then either in your trunk or on your back seat.

### **Walk Ins:**

4) Please line-up on the sidewalk along College Avenue, observing physical distance guidelines and stay in line.

5) When it is your turn, we will ask you to deposit your spring plant dividend postcard in the bucket, and hold your paper up so we can see your top choices and bring your selection to you.

### **Visiting the Gardens during Pick-up**

If you haven't been in the Arboretum lately, picking up your dividend may be a good time to visit the gardens as well. The Arboretum grounds are open to visitors, so long as the posted safety measures are practiced; please note no buildings or other facilities are open to the public at this time. Please note the Wister Center Parking lot will be closed during the Spring Plant Dividend Pickup. Please plan your visit accordingly.

**Safety Notes:**

Staff members will be managing this distribution process. All staff and visitors are to wear masks at all times while on campus. Staff members working on site now take daily temperature checks to be cleared to work.
